This seminar is for those who have already had the Basic 2-day Seminar. It targets the older student (4<sup>th</sup> grade through adult) and sets up the program in a notebook format. It will cover sections M-1 through Z. Additional work will cover enrichments, grammar, and composition that would be of value to the older student even through high school. Some homework will be given each evening to help you grasp the rules, charts and concepts more quickly.

# Preparing for the 2018 Basic & Advanced Seminars

*It is my desire to help you be as organized as possible  
so that you will be better prepared to teach.*

I. One of the first things we will do is organize your materials to fit into a 3-ring zip-up notebook.

*You will need to bring:*

- A **3-inch**, zip-up notebook
- 3 packs of **8-tab** page dividers – We will mark these tabs together.
- 1 pack of 5-tab page dividers – These tabs can be marked ahead of time - *Philosophy, Steps 1-40, Log, Appendix, and Reference*
- 1 pack of **A-Z** page dividers

II. You will need to color several of the spelling rule cards with **RED INK BEFORE** you have them laminated. We will do this together in the seminar.

To color these cards, *you will need to bring:*

- **A red, fine-point, ink or permanent marker pen.**

III. You will be highlighting the SWR teacher guide for learning purposes.

*You will need to bring:*

- 5 highlighters – **yellow, green, blue, orange, and pink** (advanced will also need a **purple**) These 6 colors are usually sold together in a pack.

IV. You will be writing and marking in your logbook.

*You will need to bring:*

- A # 2 pencil (regular or mechanical)
- **A red colored pencil**
- 6” ruler
- Some notebook paper

*(While you are shopping for yourself, each of your students  
will also need their own #2 pencils, a **red pencil** and a 6” ruler.)*

All of these supplies should be readily available at Office Depot, Target, Walmart, Michael's or art, drafting, and school supply stores.
